<b>General Language</b>	20 Basic	20 lessons per week, 4 lessons per day. 2 lessons are dedicated to reading, listening comprehension, vocabulary and conversational skills and 2 lessons focus on grammar structures, written practice and general language review. <b>Cultural Activity Programme</b>	25 Intensive	25 lessons per week. The morning classes are structured in the same way as the Basic course.
